GrandOak Engineered construction - designed for life.

As today's market is seeing an increase in wider and longer boards, the need for stability in the construction of engineered floorboards is forever evolving. The use of a multi-ply core is paramount to the longevity of your engineered timber floor. Stability is key in the construction of engineered flooring, creating a floor that is less likely to cup, twist or bow when affected by environmental extremes in temperature and humidity.

GrandOak uses the proven superior method of a multi-ply cross core. This unique assembling method creates a product more stable than that of a 3-ply construction. Multi-ply construction is made up of multiple thin hardwood sheets that are arranged, glued, and pressed with the grain running at right angles to the adjacent sheet.



GrandOak

Tongue and Groove joining system is the preferred choice.

Over the generations, the Tongue & Groove joining system has been tried and tested. To this day, the T&G joining system is still the preferred choice amongst most builders and floor installers because there are less issues in laying the boards, and less issues in movement!

The use of a T&G joining system also gives you more options when it comes to the installation process. The prime benefit of a T&G profile is that you can choose to use a 'Glue Down Method' or a 'Floating Floor Method' option.

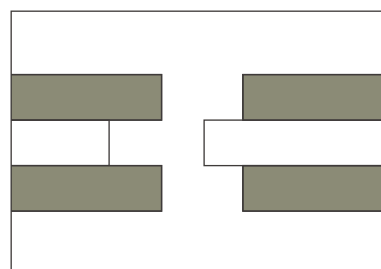
Glue Down - Installation Method:

- Compared to other locking systems, T&G direct sticking is easy to install, easy to use; and this results in a perfectly solid feeling with no movement (subject to leveling first where required). Glue is applied by a professional directly under the boards for a stable finish.

Floating Floor - Installation Method:

- Where floating floor method is preferred, the T&G locking system requires the use of a cross-linking PVA adhesive between the boards. This secure bond reduces any potential creaking and squeaking from your floor, and ensures the locking system does not loosen up. The glue between the joints also acts as a sealant, so that in case of any spillages, it limits water ingress.

It's always best to confirm which method of installation suits your 'subfloor' with a professional installer, however the T&G locking system makes it a versatile option in any home!

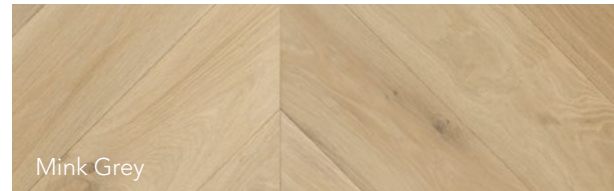
Inspired by century-old styling, our GrandOak Chevron Collection provides an effortless modern appearance with its unique pattern.

Chevron parquetry is known for its 'V' shape pattern, also known as Hungarian point which dates back to the Renaissance period. It consists of wood planks that are cut at a 45-degree angle and positioned in a distinctive pattern. This must be aligned for a perfectly straight axis; parquetry requires specialised skills for installation. With its repeated geometrical pattern, this style has been featured in many European palaces and chateaux.

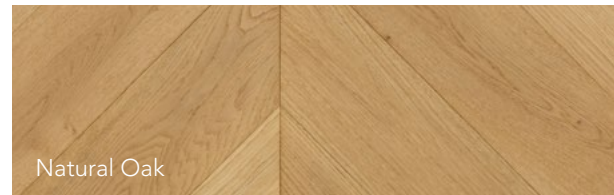
